Activities Overview

- Youth will receive the **Be Red Cross Ready** training on disaster preparedness along with an overview on planning presentations and **Public Speaking**. Critical thinking skills will be developed as they explore different perspectives regarding **Cultural Diversity** and are faced with complex questions.
- A full day of lifesaving training in **First Aid, CPR and AED** is included.
- Youth will develop **Effective Communication** skills. They will explore **Leadership Styles** and learn about the importance of **Teamwork**.
- Raid Cross** is an activity that uses international humanitarian law as an instrument for encouraging more extensive thought about human behavior. It focuses on the protection of life and human dignity in wartime and, more generally, in all the experiences of daily life.
- Youth will learn how to start a Red Cross Club by developing a constitution and learning how to run meetings. They will additionally be trained in programs that they can use to become Red Cross Ambassadors in their communities.
