

# E-Reader User Agreement



This year, students are able to use electronic readers (e-readers) in school. While it is exciting that students are using new technology to nurture their love of reading, there are some rules for the appropriate use of these devices.

Point Pleasant Borough Schools and its staff are not responsible for lost, stolen, or damaged e-readers. If a student brings an e-reader to school, it is that student's responsibility to maintain possession of, and care for, his or her e-reader.

Rules for using e-readers:

10. All e-readers must be labeled with the student's first and last name.
11. Each student is solely responsible for his or her own e-reader and is strongly cautioned *not* to lend it to another student while in school.

E-readers should not be left in classrooms. (Notify your teacher if your class is leaving the room & you have an e-reader in your bag.)

12. E-readers can be used in class only when the teacher gives the student permission. If a student is using an e-reader at an inappropriate time, the teacher may revoke student permission to use the e-reader during that class.
13. E-readers are to be used for reading and teacher-approved school work only. Any student found to be using his/her e-reader for unapproved activity or Internet access during school hours will lose his/her privileges.

Books must be downloaded at home, prior to coming to school.

14. E-readers may not be used for audio books, music, or movies in school.
15. The privilege to use an e-reader can be revoked at any time.
