#### School Safety Information

- Maintaining a safe learning environment for the children of Point Pleasant Borough remains the Point Pleasant Borough School District's top priority. Please be aware that safety strobe lights on the exterior of district school buildings act as part of an integrated emergency communications system. In the event of an emergency, the strobe lights are activated, serving the dual purpose of alerting law enforcement personnel of the situation while communicating to any students, staff and parents who are outside the building to *stay away and to not attempt to enter the building*. The lights are used during drills as well as during actual emergencies.

#### Winter weather is coming!

- Students will have outdoor recess if the temperature is above freezing. Please be sure that your child wears a coat, hat, and gloves to school when the weather is chilly!
- The Honeywell Instant Alert System is used to notify parents of school closings, delayed openings, and emergency dismissals. Please be sure that you have activated your Honeywell account and verified that your contact information is correct at: <http://instantalert.honeywell.com>
