Re: **Special PSAT Schedule**

Dear Parent /Guardian:

On Wednesday October 11th, all students in grades 10 and 11 will participate in the administration of the Preliminary SAT (PSAT). The *Official Student Guide to the PSAT* which includes test taking tips and a practice test has been distributed in grades 10 and 11 English classes. There is **no charge** or **registration** procedure necessary for the PSAT. Students in grades 9 and 12 will have a delayed start to their school day due to testing. Period one will not occur on Wednesday, October 11th.

Grades 10 & 11

The PSAT will be utilized for college planning for the class of 2019 and beyond. In addition, The PSAT, as well as the SAT can also be used as an assessment to meet New Jersey State graduation testing requirements. It is very important that your student takes advantage of this opportunity. The PSAT will start promptly at **8:00 AM**. Students will report directly to their testing rooms which will be posted a few days prior to testing in their English classes, as well as the Main Office and Guidance Services. At the conclusion of the test, all students will report to their homeroom.

The PSAT is excellent preparation for the SAT. All students who take the PSAT will receive a personalized score report clearly indicating areas that may need attention in preparing for the SAT. Students will be able to go to collegeboard.org/psatpractice for free and practice for the SAT based on their recent PSAT performance.

Grades 9 and 12

Students in grades 9 and 12 will report to school at **10:00 AM**. All grade 9 students will report to the Auditorium. All grade 12 students will report to the Gym. At the conclusion of the test, all students will report to their homerooms

OCTVHS

Students in participating in the PSAT will not attend their vocational school program on October 19th. All other Vocation school students should report to their buses at the regular times.
