Proposed Changes for 2018-2019 Requiring State Board Approval

- Maintain grades 3-8 assessment requirements
- Maintain ELA 9 and ELA 10
- Maintain Grades 9 and 10 math assessments
 - Either take Algebra I, Geometry, or Algebra II depending on the course the child is in
- Maintain Science assessment
- Loosen graduation requirements to allow multiple pathways of graduation if students do not pass the state testing requirements

Proposed Changes for 2018-2019 Not Requiring State Board Approval

- Reduce the sections in the tests and reduce the minutes the students are testing
- Change assessment name from PARCC to New Jersey Student Learning Assessments--ELA and Math

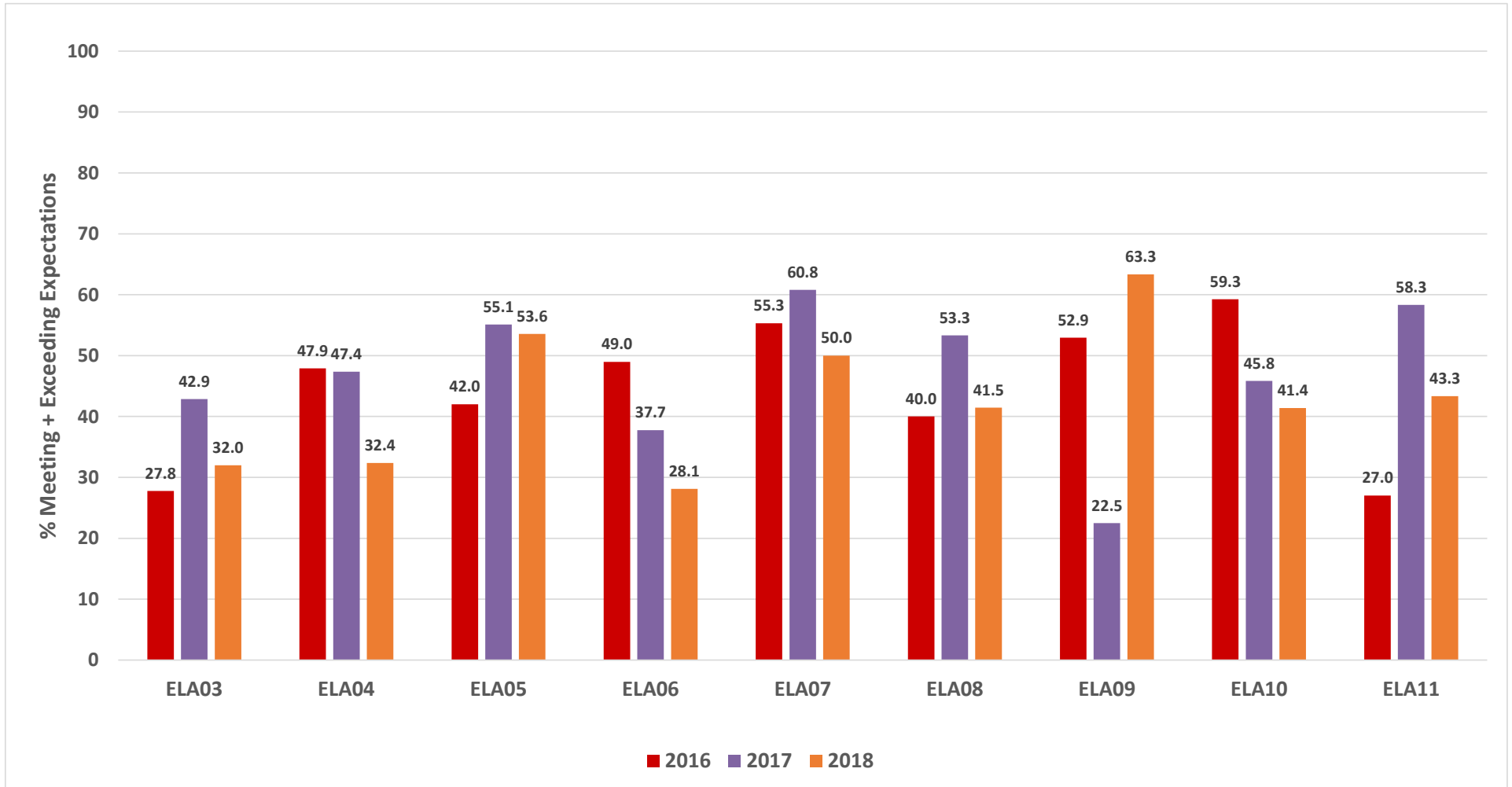

Performance of Economically Disadvantaged Subgroup over 3 Years

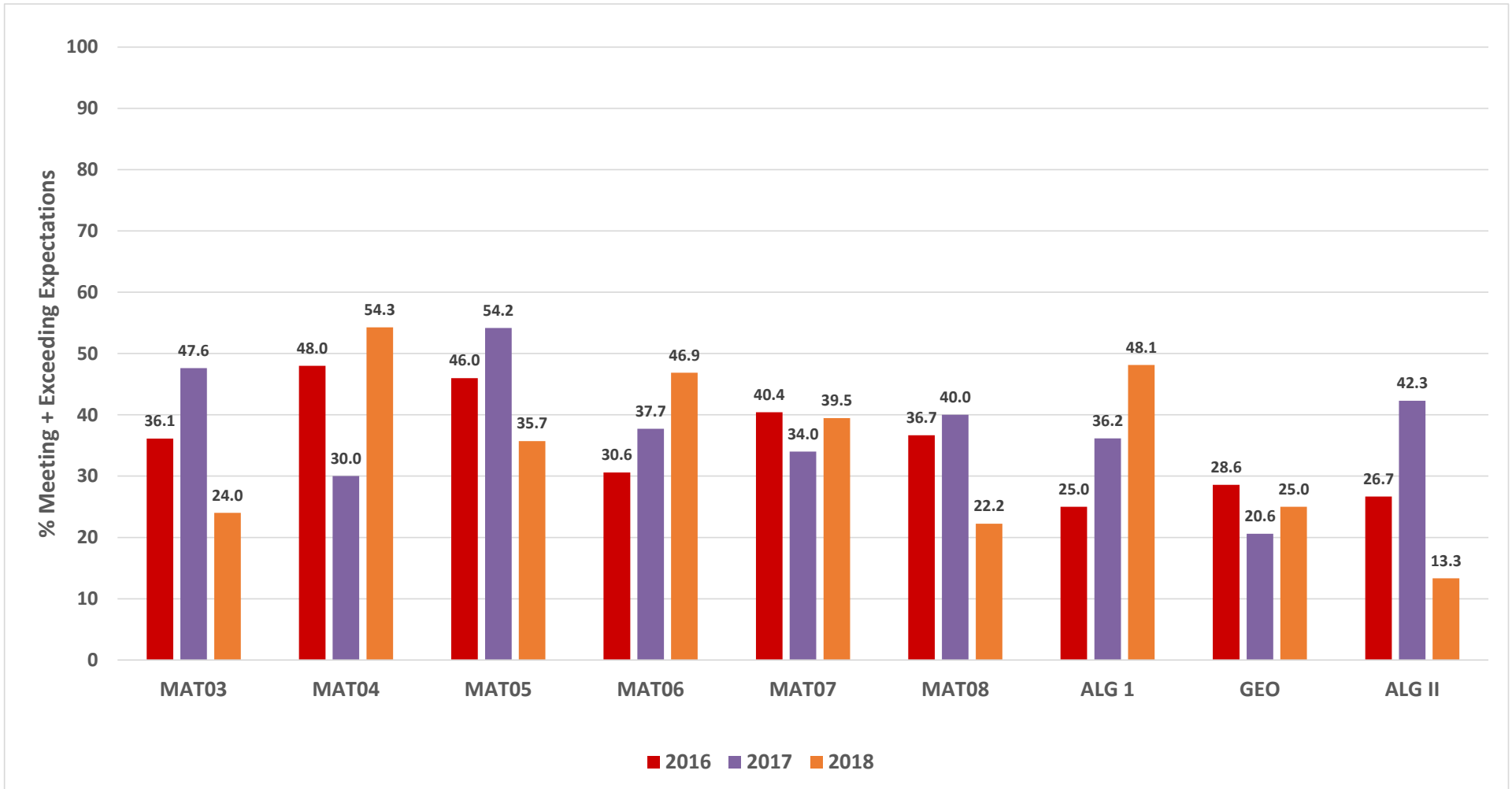

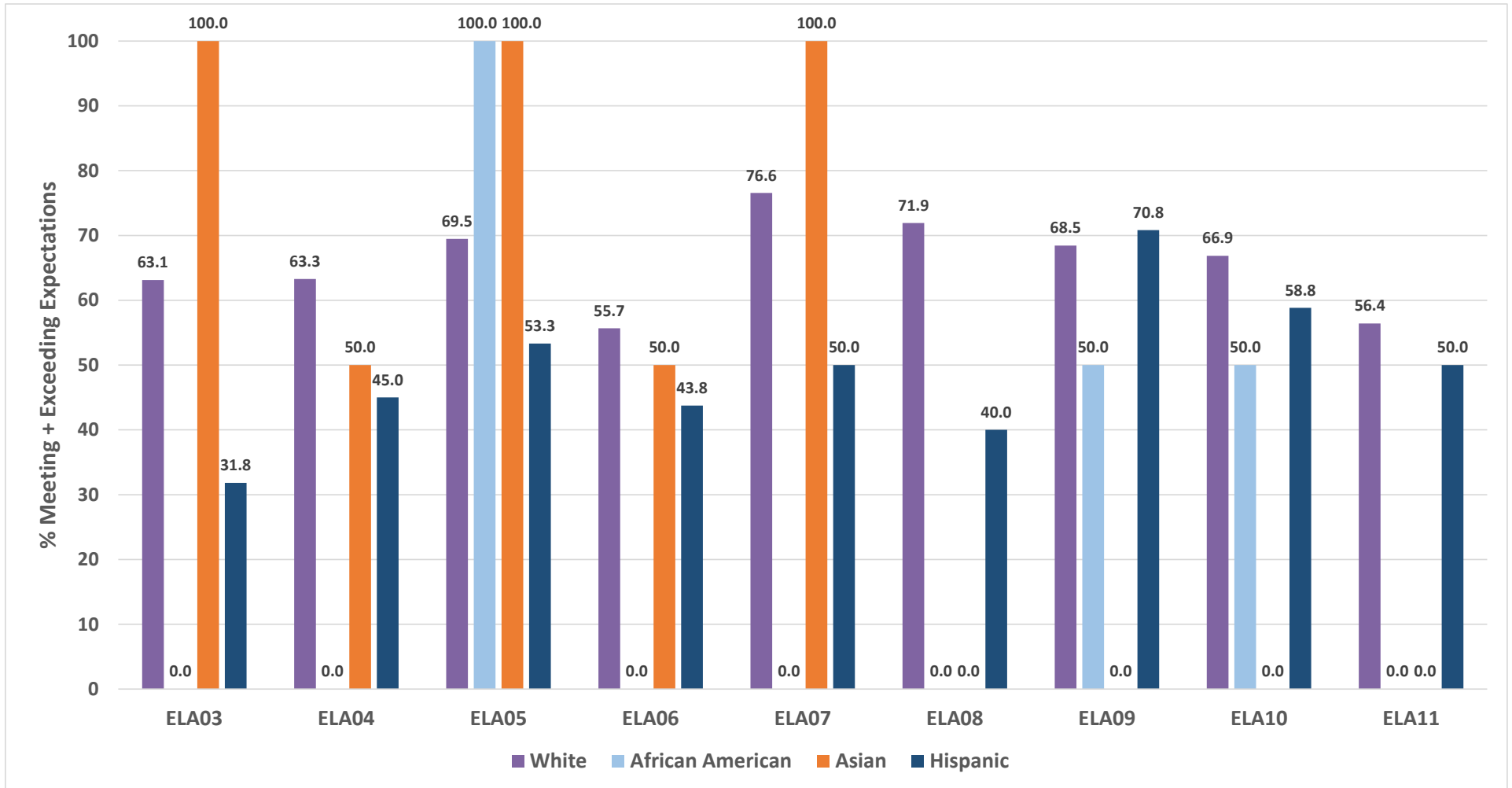
