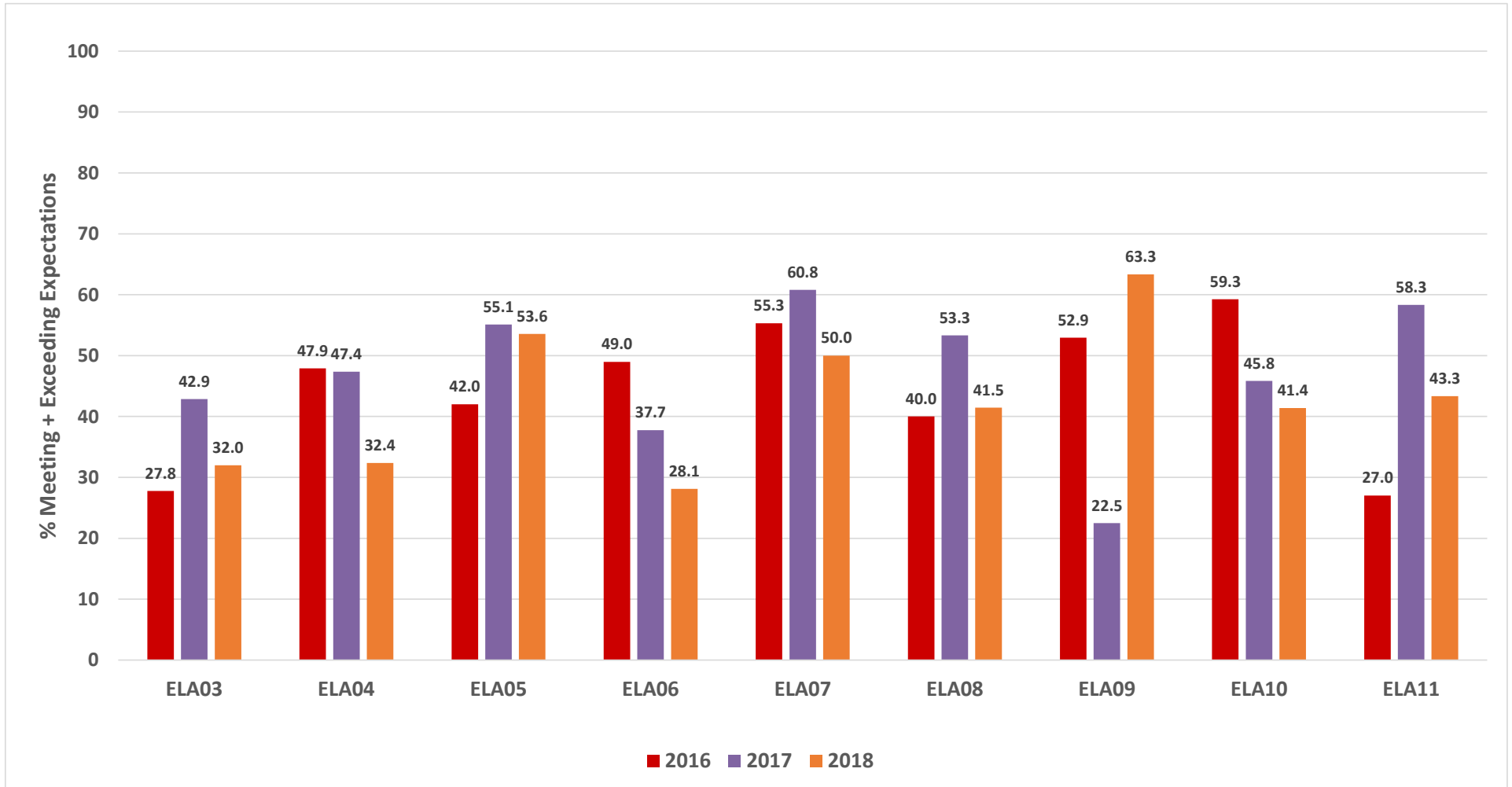

Performance of Economically Disadvantaged Subgroup over 3 Years

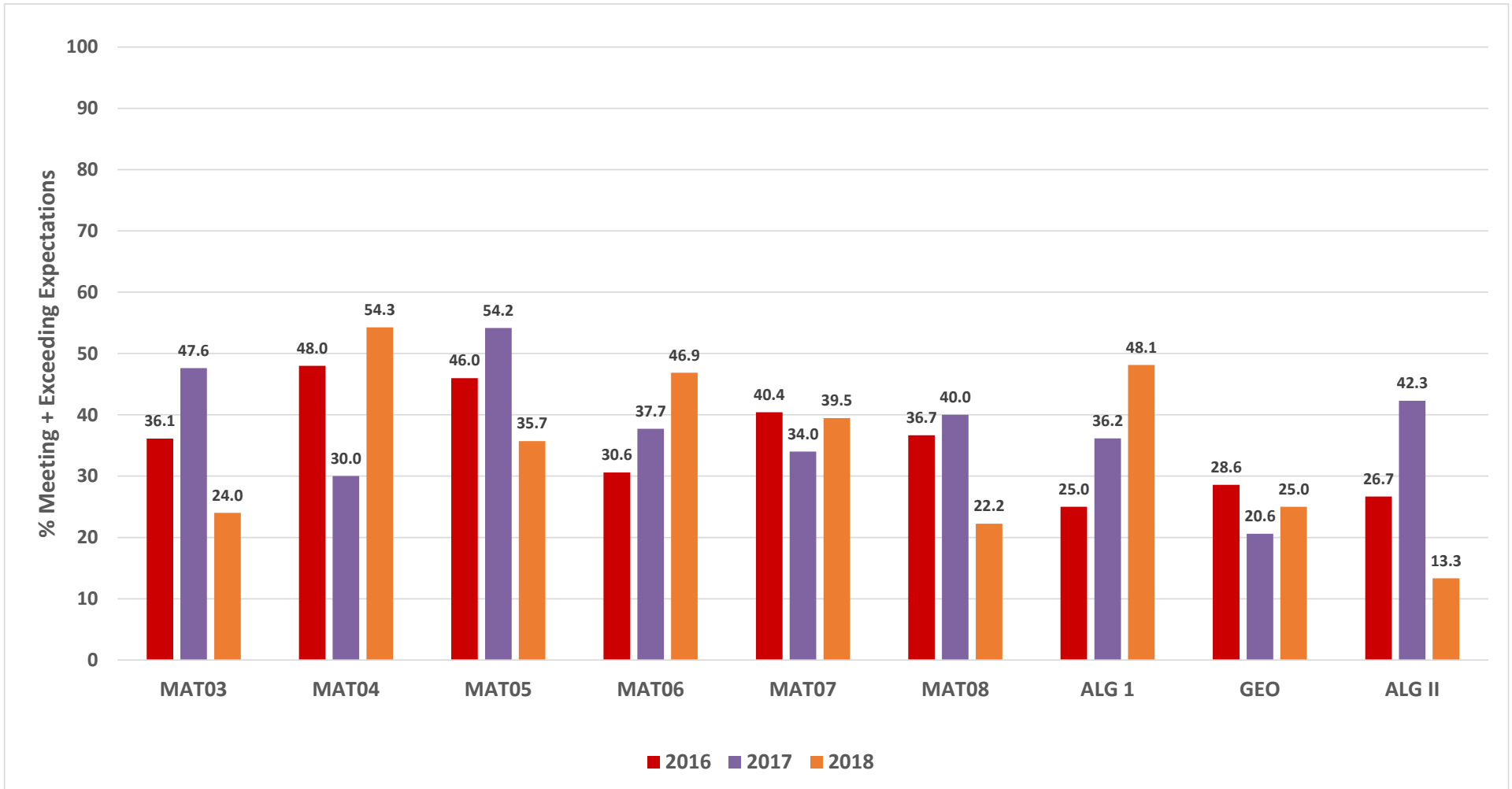

Performance of Economically Disadvantaged Subgroup over 3 Years

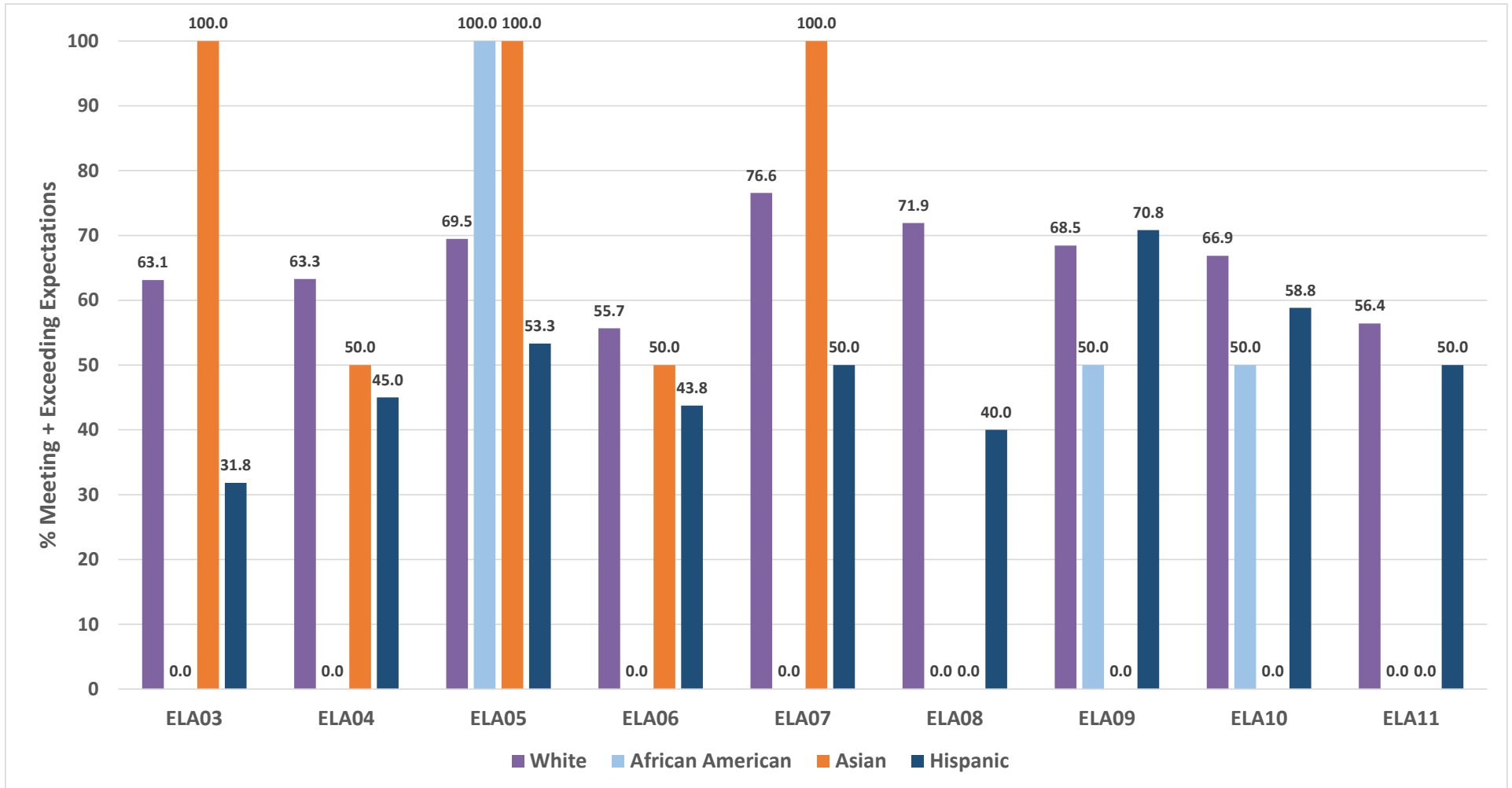
