Photo ID Required in All District Schools

Please note that visitors to all district schools will be required to show photo ID when signing in at the main office and when signing students out of school early. All visitors must provide photo ID for every visit. Visitors without photo ID will not be allowed to enter student areas or sign students out early. Please be sure to have your ID with you when you enter the building. While these procedures may cause inconvenience, the safety of your children is our paramount concern. Thank you in advance for cooperating with these best practices.

New Procedure for Dropping Off Lunch and Other Items

Parents are discouraged from dropping off lunch, library books, and other “forgotten” items during the school day. Packing a backpack with all needed items each morning or evening is a great way to teach children organization and responsibility! If you must drop off an item, the new procedure is as follows: Please ring the buzzer at the main entrance. You will be buzzed into the glass vestibule and should place the item on the cart. Please label the item with your child's name and homeroom. Please exit the building immediately without entering the main office. The cart will be checked regularly and items will be distributed to students.

Arrival and Dismissal Reminders

Please note the following regarding student arrival and dismissal:

- The area in front of the Catherine Street sidewalk is for “rolling drop off” at arrival time. Parents may not exit their cars or park in this area. If your child needs assistance in exiting the car, please park elsewhere and escort your child to the arrival area.
- Please drive with caution at arrival and dismissal time to ensure the safety of our students and their families. Please observe the posted “No Parking” zones, and please cross Catherine Street only at the crossing guard. Parents are not permitted to pull into the rear driveway or rear parking lot at arrival and dismissal time.

November 2018 Ballot Question

Point Pleasant residents will have the opportunity to vote to approve a ballot question appropriating an additional \$198,000 for the 2018-2019 school year. The purpose of these funds will be used to cover the costs for four full-time municipality police officers to provide security in the Point Pleasant School District during school hours. Approval of the question will result in a permanent increase in the district's tax levy. If the question is approved, officers will remain in district schools for the current school year and into the future. If the question is not approved, the district will not be able to fund the expenditure to keep the officers in schools.
