**Please also remind your child to come prepared with sharpened # 2 pencils and a calculator.**

*Performing well on the PSAT is important because it provides an indicator of areas of strength and improvement so that students may perform better on the SAT. The results can also be linked to Khan Academy so that your child may work on the areas where they show the greatest need for improvement prior to sitting for the SAT. Additionally, the data produced as a result of the PSAT provides insightful information as to Advanced Placement (AP) classes where your child may show a propensity to be successful. This allows parents and students to make the most informed decisions about the academic courses selected during the scheduling process.*

**OCVTVHS-** Students participating in the PSAT will not attend their vocational program on October 10th. All other vocational school students should report to their buses at regular time.

**Students in Grades 9 and 12** will have a delayed opening, where they will be expected to report to school at **10:00 AM. Attendance will be taken.**
