Learning Resource Center-South Now Open at Rowan University

The New Jersey Department of Education (NJDOE) has re-opened the Learning Resource Center-South. The new location is James Hall 1140, Rowan University, Glassboro, NJ 08028.

The NJDOE operates four regional Learning Resource Centers (LRCs): Besides Glassboro, LRCs are located in Morris Plains, East Orange and Trenton. The LRC staff provides regional in-service workshops, training institutes, statewide conferences, consultations, and technical assistance to educators and parents of students with disabilities. Current special-education information is available at the LRCs through library media, professional journals, video/DVD collections, and access to online research relevant to educators and parents having responsibility for children and youth with disabilities ages 3-21. In addition, the LRCs maintain and loan an extensive collection of professional books, in-service training resources, activity books, videos/DVDs and instructional materials to support all areas of the general education curriculum.

There is a \$2 annual membership fee that allows access to all of the LRCs.

Additional services provided by the LRC-South include:

- A production area in an open workroom with laminators, Ellison machines, poster printers, button-makers, and more;
- A resource-lending service from an extensive library of current materials.
- Monthly events that include a “Make It and Take It” workshop area that allows teachers to create classroom materials; family and community events; educator workshops; and “Webinar Wednesdays.”
